aged 6-16 to stay with us for a few weeks, while Social Services try to find their families.

We opened the home in February and so far we have had eleven girls come to stay. They have all been glad to have a safe place to sleep and to eat three meals each day.

The girls have been learning to read and write,



and to do some Maths. They have also been playing volleyball, doing lots of drawing and colouring, and growing vegetables in our garden.

We have lots of women who save **Self-Help** money together in groups. We call them Self-Help Groups. As well as saving money, the groups are good friends together.




In February we had heavy rains in Harare, and some of the houses were swept away. So the women in the groups made bricks to re-build one family's house. Now they have a new start in their new home.

PSP A lot of the children in our Pre-Schools are often ill, sometimes because they do not have enough food to eat. This means they cannot learn well and they fall behind in school. In March, our Pre-School team took nurses to lots of our schools to see which children were ill and give them medicine so they can feel better.



We have a lot of different schools so the staff and the nurses had to drive around for three weeks to get to them all. But it was worth it, because most of the children are now feeling better and they are able to learn more at school.

Central We have had a new start at our Oasis centre since Christmas, because all our building work


has been finished! We had a new front wall and a new car park built, and in one of our buildings we had new floors, new ceilings, new toilets and lots of painting.
