## Applying for Secondary School (year 7) place

Closing date: 11.59 pm 31 October 2021

The following is important advice to maximise your child's chances of securing the school you want.

1. Apply for up to six secondary schools, listing them in order of preference. Please note: You don't have to list six schools, but the more schools you list, the better your chances of being offered a place at one of them.
2. Consider each school's admissions policies and previous years' application rates to see whether your child is likely to be offered a place. Reflect on the distance, cohort and environment to suit your child.
3. Apply before the deadline to avoid disappointment October 31, 2021.
