REMINDER **Reception 2022 Application Process**

Parents have until 11.59pm on 15 January 2022 to submit their applications for a Reception place for their child.

You can apply for a Reception place for your child, if you live in Birmingham and if your **child was born between 1 September 2017 and 31 August 2018**. Birmingham City Council will only deal with applications for school places if you live in Birmingham and pay council tax to the authority.

and submit an online application by 15th January 2022.

It is important that you apply on time as any applications received after the 15 January 2022 will be classed as late applications and will be processed after the national offer day of 19 April 2022 and late applicants are less likely to be offered a place at any of their preferred schools.
