# SUMMER OF FUN

'Bring it on Brum!' is Birmingham's Department for Education funded, Holiday Activity and Food Programme, that's helping children, young people and their families have active, fun-filled and healthy school holidays.

Bring it on Brum! is for children who go to school in Birmingham and **are eligible for benefits-related free school meals. Visit the website for more information: [www.BringitonBrum.co.uk](http://www.BringitonBrum.co.uk)**

Our summer holiday programme will be delivered in over 260 venues across the City. Holiday activity providers are ready to take bookings now.

Most programmes will run for 4 week over the summer holidays. Bookings are be limited to 16 days/sessions for each young person.

**The holiday clubs are designed for children who are eligible for benefits-related free school meals.**

**If your child is eligible and you wish to use the programme, please contact the school for a Bring it on Brum! code (sometimes called a HAF or Free School Meal code).**

You will be asked to provide this code when you book or when you register with your chosen holiday activity provider. If you do not have a code please contact your child's school. For more information on the codes check out our website.
