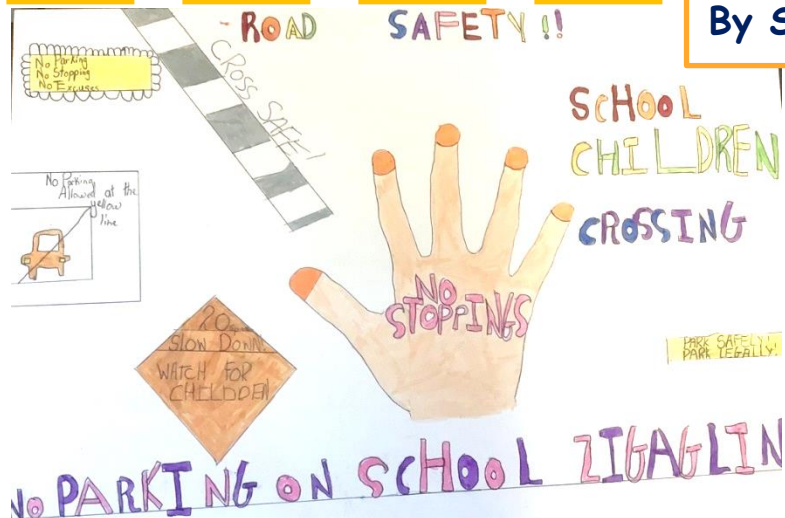
Our Year 4 and 5 children applied for the role of Junior PCSO

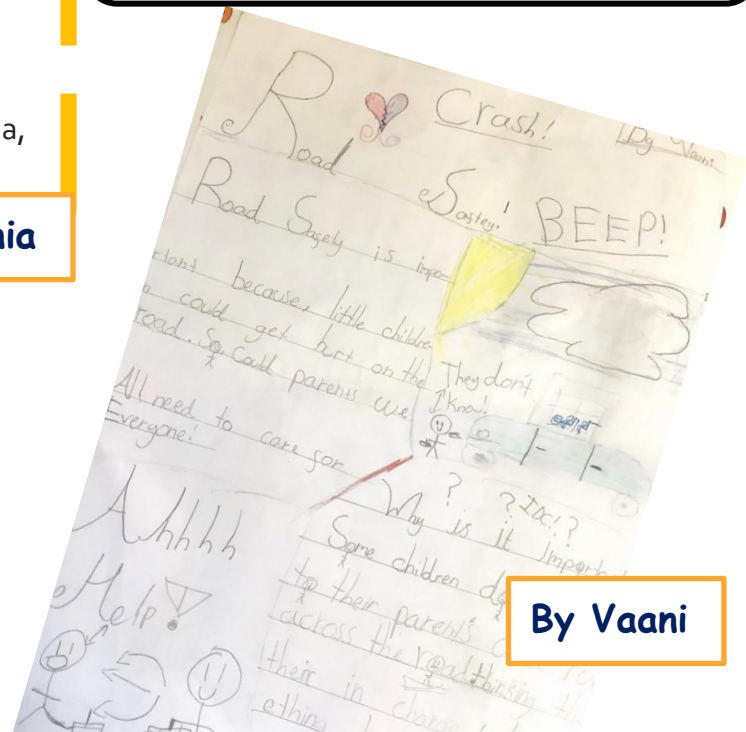
