Applying for Secondary School (year 7) place

Closing date: 11.59 pm 31 October 2022

The following is important advice to maximise your child's chances of securing the school you want.

- 1. Apply for up to six secondary schools, listing them in order of preference. Please note: You don't have to list six schools, but the more schools you list, the better your chances of being offered a place at one of them.
- 2. Consider each school's admissions policies and previous years' application rates to see whether your child is likely to be offered a place. Reflect on the distance, cohort and environment to suit your child.
- 3. Apply before the deadline to avoid disappointment October 31, 2022.
