## Nut Free School - Reminder to all Years

Please do not send your child into school with any nut-based product for a snack or packed lunch – this includes products that may contain traces of nuts. Potential allergens could include the following:

- Spreads, e.g. chocolate spread
- Cereal bars
- Some types of biscuit containing nuts
- Condiments, e.g. satay sauce
- Cakes containing nuts
- Some snack pots containing nuts



It is important that you check the labelling of food products before sending your child in to school with them – it is not always apparent that products contain nuts or traces of nuts.

We understand that these measures may seem extreme; however, we want to ensure the health and safety of all our pupils, we have pupils in school who have allergies to nuts and one so severe that even the slightest of contact with nuts would cause a severe and potentially life-threatening reaction.

Due to the severity of the pupil's allergy, if any pupil is found with a nut-based product, the school will have to confiscate and dispose of the item immediately.
