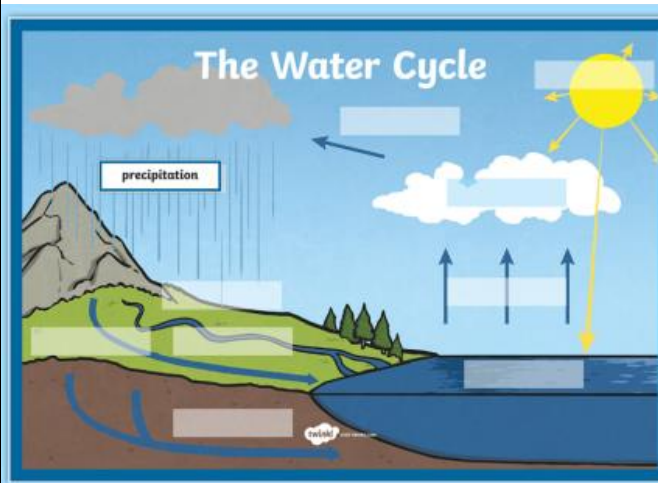


Topic, Science and Spanish Activities
